## Digital Video Resource Library DVD & CD

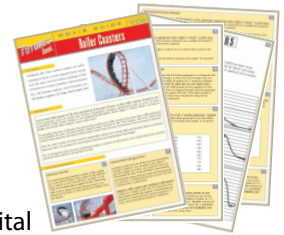
